- Conduct market and competitor analysis and present insights to the team
- Coordinate fabric approvals for SMS and bulk production
- Travel to and visit suppliers and factories as part of the development process
- Own the full development journey from first sketch to final approval — keeping all milestones, actions, and timelines updated and aligned.
